Today the Cross Displays the color red for Pentecost Sunday. Red is the color of the Holy Spirit. It calls to mind the flames that descended upon the Church on the Day of Pentecost and is used for the commemoration of the martyred saints. Red recalls the blood shed for the Faith and the Church (See Acts 2).
